## Criteria for consideration

***The nominee should meet some, but not necessarily all, of the following criteria. The nominee may not be an active employee of Covington Independent Public Schools.***

- Nominee attended or served Holmes High School or contributed to its welfare.
- Alumni nominee can be from any year since the establishment of Holmes High School provided credentials are verified.
- Alumni nominee must be ten years removed from Holmes High School unless deceased, in which case, the time limit is removed.
- Nominee shall have good moral character as determined by the selection committee.
- Nominee may be a recognized leader in the community; or
  - have had a significant impact through involvement or activities at Holmes; or
  - have distinguished themselves through achievements while a student at Holmes; or
  - have distinguished themselves through their support of education within the school district; or
  - have distinguished themselves through their community involvement; or
  - have distinguished themselves through their generous financial or non-financial support of the mission of the board of education to provide a quality education for all children of the community.
- Nominee may be an acknowledged leader in the community whose professional and community service is recognized by peers and associates as truly outstanding.
- Non-alumni nominee should have a clear affinity with or connection to Holmes High School and the Covington board of education.
- Nominee has shown an interest in and support for Holmes High School.
- Nominee may have established a personal reputation at the local, state, or national level for outstanding character and citizenship for a period of time sufficient in length to reflect, without reservation, great credit and honor upon Holmes High School.
- Nominee may have demonstrated distinguished service to their profession including interest in and dedication to Holmes High School.
