**CRITERIA**

**1. ELIGIBILITY - APPLICANT MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING CRITERIA:**

- B. Be accepted to an institution of higher learning.
- C. Be graduating high school within 9 months.
- D. Scholarship program available to high school students only.
- E. Employees of the Law Firm Adams, Stepner, Woltermann & Dusing PLLC., and immediate family members are not eligible for this essay contest.

**2. REQUIREMENTS:**

The following documents must be provided for consideration (.doc, .docx, or .pdf format only) to the attention of local scholarships via email only to [local.scholarships@covington.kyschools.us](mailto:local.scholarships@covington.kyschools.us).

- A. An official copy of a current academic transcript.
- B. Proof of legal residency in U.S. (i.e. birth certificate, passport, driver's license, permanent resident card, etc.).
- C. Proof of acceptance to an institution of higher learning. Should a winner be chosen that is still waiting on an acceptance letter, candidate will have until May 15th to provide proof of acceptance before forfeiting the prize.
- D. A one-page essay of no less than 500 and no more than 750 words on one of the following topics:
