SERVICES AND REFERRALS

The Family Resource Center can provide or make referrals for the following services:

- Full-time preschool childcare for 2- and 3-year-old children
- After-school childcare for children 4-12 years old
- Families in Training for new and expectant parents
- Health Services
- PACE-like, Family Literacy
- Other optional components

The Family Resource Center may also be able to assist your family with:

- Clothing and shoes
- Hygiene products
- Volunteer opportunities
- And much more!

The Family Resource Center also assists teachers and staff with activities such as coordinating volunteers, arranging field trip assistance, some after-school programming, co-sponsoring family nights, co-organizing assemblies and plenty of awards and incentives for students and families.

FRC ADVISORY COUNCIL

Each Family Resource Center has an Advisory Council that encourages involvement from the community. Council must be comprised of at least one-third parent members; not more than one-third school district staff and at least two youth. Parents must be representative of parent population served by the center and may not be employees of the school district.
