

CHAMPS

Dear Parents and Guardians,

At Glenn O. Swing we implement, CHAMPS, a school-wide behavior system. CHAMPS helps students to be more responsible for their behavior and learn self-control. The goal is to improve the school environment with positive behaviors. CHAMPS requires teachers and school staff to give specific directions for different subjects and transitions during the day. These directions help students focus on what is expected during a lesson or activity. Throughout the school and classrooms, CHAMPS posters are posted indicating what is expected of students during that time.

What does CHAMPS stand for?

C	CONVERSATION - Voice level of 0,1,2 or 3
H	HELP - A student can get help by raising their hand
A	ACTIVITY - tells students the activity such a group work or independent work
M	MOVEMENT - tells students to stay in seat, walk quietly or line up
P	PARTICIPATION - tells students the best way to participate in the activity
S	SUCCESS!

CHAMPS also teaches students to be responsible for themselves using **Guidelines for Success**. We expect students to be:

- Respectful
- Responsible &
- Ready to Learn

Students that follow the CHAMPS expectations and show positive behavior on the daily WILDCAT chart are rewarded monthly with a dance, outdoor recess or Wii time.
