

## Grades 3-5 Behavior System Information

### Classroom Rules

Glenn O. Swing students are respectful, responsible, and ready to learn!

Glenn O. Swing students are expected to come to class every day, be on time, come prepared with all work and materials, complete all class work, be an active learner, and show respect for themselves and others.

### Student Expectations

Students will travel to three classes daily and work for approximately 2 hours in each class.

In each class students will complete multiple choice, short answer, and extended response questions, work collaboratively with partners and groups, and be held accountable for their behavior and assignments.

Students will complete all assignments in a timely fashion and to the level of ability expected by the teacher, or will use their free time to complete the assignments. (Free times are lunch, recess, specials, and after school).

### Color Chart

- Colors:
  - Purple – Amazing! High above expectations
  - Blue – Great job! Above expectations
  - Green – Good job! Following expectations
  - Yellow – No recess
  - Orange – Silent Lunch and no recess
  - Red – detention or other consequence from teacher
- Students begin on green daily. Students move their clips to different colors based on their behavior each day.
- Students rarely rise above green. Green means they are following expectations.
- Students can move a clip down for not following the Essential 25 such as not making eye contact, eye rolling, or other disrespectful actions, not using manners, or not following along when reading.
- Students can move a clip down for not following other school and classroom rules, such as forgetting materials or not being responsible.
